History & Purpose

In Edmonton, Sons of Norway traces its origins

to April 1913 when Nordpolen Lodge, forerunner of the current Solglyt Lodge 4-143.

Edmonton became the site of one of the first lodges formed in Canada by Sons of Norway, a fraternal, social and volunteer organization. Sons of Norway was founded in Minneapolis, Minnesota, in 1895 by 18 Norwegian immigrants to provide financial protection for those families. (Life insurance and other financial products only available in the US)

Home office is in Minneapolis, MN, with a total of eight districts in USA, western Canada and Norway.

Sons of Norway is approximately 52,000 members strong with 300 lodges in North America and Norway, eight districts in total. We are in Zone 4 (AB & SK), and part of District 4, which is AB, SK & ND, MT (USA). BC has its own district - #7.
