About Us - This showcases Solglyt and Sons of Norway history. The Officers and Directors are listed and a few other links that pertain to our outreach are provided.

Membership - Contains information about dues and membership renewal. Sons of Norway home office in Minneapolis accepts payment in Canadian dollars by cheque only. Membership cards are mailed and contain a unique number for each member. *Click on 'First Time Portal User' and follow the instructions to create a username and password. Calendar - A calendar also appears on the Home page.

Photos page - 'Album Sets' and 'photostream' shows Solglyt events since about 2011. Due to privacy concerns, members in these Flickr photos have not been identified; however, it does provide a glimpse of our activities.
